

GIRLS

Jumper (Grades K-8): #7255 Navy/green plaid split front with solid pleats *Hemline to knee **Jumper** (Grades 5-8): #7455 Navy/green plaid split front with box pleat *Hemline to knee

Dress Pants: Navy – no contrasting stitching /labels, parachute pants, prefaded pants, flair leg pants, and pants

with exterior pockets are not permitted. Must match uniform style. *No skinny leg

Uniform Shorts: Navy – worn 1st and 4th quarter (all grades) **Hemline close to knee*

Round Collar Blouse: Yellow – short / long sleeve (K-4) may be worn under jumper or with shorts/pants.

Button Down Oxford: Yellow – short / long sleeve (all grades) may be worn under jumper or with shorts/pants

Knit Polo Shirt: Yellow – short / long sleeve (all grades) may be worn under jumper or with shorts/ pants

Sweaters: Navy – Crew/V-neck cardigan, crew/V-neck pullover or vest with embroidered crest on left chest or Solid

Navy *No longer than hip length, Logo or brand name no bigger than a business card.

Sweatshirts: Navy and no hood; with Saint Mary crest left chest or Crewneck Solid Navy with no logo

Fleece - Navy with embroidered crest on left chest. * No other fleece is permitted

Socks / Tights – Navy, black, or white. Any saint sock purchased from the school.

*Must come above ankle. Logo or brand name no bigger than a business card. No prints

Belt – Navy, black, or dark brown

School Dress Shoes – Navy, black, or dark brown leather *No cloth shoes, heals, or ballet flats.

School Athletic Shoes – Shoes that adhere to the athletic shoe policy are permitted

Hair Accessories – Solid color that coordinates with uniform (navy, yellow, etc.) or uniform plaid bows & headbands (1 in. wide). *This includes bead colors

Boys Dress Code



BOYS

Dress Pants: Navy –two pockets in front, no contrasting stitching or labels and may not gather at ankle. Parachute pants, prefaded pants, flair leg pants, and pants with exterior pockets are not permitted. Must match uniform style.

Uniform Shorts: Navy – worn 1st and 4th quarter (all grades) *Hemline close to knee

Knit Polo Shirt: Yellow – short / long sleeve (all grades)

Button Down Oxford: Yellow – short / long sleeve (all grades) may be worn with shorts/pants

Sweaters: Navy - Crew/V-neck cardigan, crew/V-neck pullover or vest with embroidered crest on left chest

*No longer than hip length or Solid Navy *Logo or brand name no bigger than a business card

Sweatshirts: Navy and no hood; with Saint Mary crest left chest or Crewneck Solid Navy with no logo

Fleece – Navy with embroidered crest on left chest. *No other fleece is authorized

Socks– Navy, black, or white. Any saint sock purchased from the school

*Must come above ankle. *Logo or brand name no bigger than a business card. No prints

Belt – Navy, black, or dark brown

School dress shoes – Navy, black, or dark brown leather

School Athletic Shoes – Shoes that adhere to the athletic shoe policy are permitted

Physical Education Dress Code

GYM UNIFORM

T-Shirt: Approved PE shirt with crest and mission statement. Purchase at school office for \$15. Adult sizes XXL-S, Youth sizes XL-XS **No other shirt is permitted*

Shorts: Navy blue mesh * *Logo or brand name no bigger than a business card*

Sweatshirt: Navy and no hood; with Saint Mary crest left chest or Crewneck Solid Navy with no logo

Sweatpants: Navy * Logo or brand name no bigger than a business card, no cargo style **Athletic Jacket:** Navy with Saint Mary crest left chest *No other jacket is permitted

Athletic Pants: Navy *Logo or brand name no bigger than a business card

Socks: White athletic crew socks * Logo or brand name no bigger than a business card

Athletic Shoes: Solid white, black, navy, gray or a combination of these colors. *Colors/Tones must be subdued and not bright, reflective, or flashy. *No other colors are permitted and no light up shoes or skater shoes

Hair Accessories – Solid color that coordinates with uniform (navy, yellow, white, black, gray) or uniform plaid bows or headbands. (1 in. wide) **This includes bead colors*



SAINT MARY SCHOOL DRESS POLICY

The dress policy provides more specific and descriptive guidance for the dress code and uniform policy. Students not in uniform or dress code compliance will receive a demerit for a dress code violation. As with all school policies, the decision of the administrator regarding the dress policy is final.

Girls' Plaid Jumper

- defined waist, not the drop waist style
- small pleats are worn by girls in grades K-4, large pleats for girls in grades 5-8
- hem must touch the top of the knee
- the jumper is worn with a light-yellow blouse or knit polo with a pointed, button down or rounded collar
- the blouse may have long or short sleeves; sleeves may not be rolled up
- may be worn all year

Slacks, Pants, Belts

- may not be corduroy or any other material than that sold by the uniform shops
- slacks are solid navy blue, no faded material
- no decorative trim is permitted on the slacks
- have two hidden pockets in the side seams, no pockets sewn on the exterior of the pants
- no extra zippers, pockets, labels, or contrasting stitching
- must cover the socks and must not drag on the floor
- may not be sagged, baggy or rolled up
- may not be gathered, pinned or tied at the ankle
- may not be tight fitting pants, parachute pants, or cargo pants
- a belt must always be worn with uniform pants; belts are to be solid navy, black, or brown with no decorative trim, studs, etc.
- Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 2 students may wear pants with an elastic waist
- middle school girls (Grades 6-8) may wear the flair leg, high rise, (not hip hugger) slacks offered through the approved suppliers; no other flair leg style will be acceptable
- slacks/pants may be worn all year
- PJ pants worn to school must be removed after entering the building

Shoes

- shoes must be tied or secured at all times
- may be shoestring style or Velcro fastened
- tennis shoes are permitted but may not have wheels, or inappropriate words or designs
- Crocs, jelly shoes, clogs, ballet flats, flip-flops, open-toed or sandals are not permitted
- girls may not wear high heeled shoes or platform shoes
- boots are not permitted during the school day except during recess or on dress down days

Perfume

Students may not wear perfume, scented lipgloss, or other fragrances due to the allergy and asthma conditions of many of our students, teachers, and staff members.

Makeup And Fingernails

- makeup on any part of the body is not permitted for boys or girls
- students will have to remove any makeup worn to school
- students may wear clear, unscented Chapstick or lip gloss
- girls only may wear clear nail polish;
- colored polish is not permitted
- fake fingernails or tips may not be worn in order to allow students to participate comfortably in all school projects and activities
- students may not apply stickers, glitter, paint, or ink to their clothing, skin or hair

Blouses and Shirts

- solid light-yellow blouse/shirt or knit polo
- have a pointed, button down, or rounded collar
- the blouse/shirt may have long or short sleeves; sleeves may not be rolled up
- must be long enough to be tucked in
- must be tucked in throughout the school day except during recess
- white turtleneck or T-shirts may be worn under the yellow uniform shirt during winter months. No spandex or stretchy material.

Sweaters, Sweatshirts, and Fleece

- any style cardigan, pullover or vest in solid yellow or solid navy blue
- jacket sweaters may not be worn
- all sweaters must be no longer than hip length
- sweatshirt with hoodies may not be worn during the school day, including St. Mary hoodies
- official St. Mary sweatshirts or solid navy sweatshirt with no logo
- official St Mary fleece purchased through approved supplier, no other fleece is authorized

Uniform Shorts

- Uniform shorts will be permitted during the first and fourth quarters when weather appropriate. Shorts may not be tight fitting, sagged, baggy, or rolled up.
- Navy uniform material walking, knee length shorts
- have two hidden pockets in the side seams, no pockets sewn on the exterior of the shorts
- a belt must always be worn with shortsTransitional-K,
 Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 2 students may wear shorts with an elastic waist

Socks

- must be worn at all times
- anklets, crew socks, sport socks or knee socks are permitted
- navy blue, black, or white tights or leggings (for girls) may be worn; no artwork, words, or logos.
- nylon stockings (hose) are not permitted

Hats

 Hats, scarves, bandannas, or other head coverings may not be worn inside the school building or in church.

Jewelry:

- No precious or expensive jewelry
- inappropriate jewelry will be confiscated
- no bracelets or ankle breaclet of any kind may be worn
- no rings or toe rings may be worn
- one watch may be worn; however it may not be noisy or distracting to others
- Smart watches must have internet or cellular coverage disabled
- girls may wear one pair of stud type earrings, one earring in each ear; no other piercings are allowed; boys may not wear earrings
- earrings that dangle below the lobe of the ear are not permitted
- hoop earrings of any size are not permitted
- necklaces may have a small cross or religious medal
- lanyards, long neckwear, or keys on neckwear are not permitted
- dog collars, choke style necklaces, or large link chains may not be worn
- students may not have tattoos

NON-UNIFORM DRESS POLICY

Occasionally, the administrator approves non-uniform days called jean days, dress down, or dress up days. On those days, students must maintain a neat appearance. Administrators may provide more detailed guidance prior to the non-uniform event. These special days are offered for a small cost (typically no more than \$2). Parents will be called to bring appropriate clothing if their child arrives at school dressed inappropriately.

Standing dress down days are three times per year. They are the last day of school before Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter/Spring breaks.

Additionally, students may dress down for their birthday with no charge.

Students with summer birthdays may dress down on their half birthday.

Occasionally, other dress down days are earned as a special token of appreciation from administrators. Students will receive a dress down pass for individual awards or an email pass to parents for whole class dress downs.

Dress up days are typically reserved for special occasions such as certain feast days or holy days. Dress up days may also be assigned for picture days. Tshirts, shorts, and sweatpants are not permitted on dress up days.

Students are permitted to wear the following:

- dresses and skirts of appropriate length and neckline
- pants, jeans, sweat pants, and knee length shorts
- the standard uniform
- Appropriate tshirts with sleeves
- shoes and socks as in the standard uniform policy with the exception of color requirements
- *jewelry as stated in the standard uniform policy*
- hairstyles as stated in the standard uniform policy
- all clothing and jewelry must have appropriate artwork and wording

Students are not permitted to wear the following:

- any clothing with inappropriate words, graphics, or artwork
- makeup, perfume, or colored nail polish
- low cut neckline blouses, t-shirts, or other tops
- shirts/tops that show the midriff; shirts must cover the waistband of the shorts, pants or skirts
- tight fitting jeans, pants, shorts, skirts, blouses/tops, dresses including leggings
- Jeans with rips above the knee, unless tights or leggings are worn underneath
- clothing that drags on the floor
- shorts that are shorter than two inches of the knee
- shirts with more than the top button unbuttoned
- mesh shirts, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, or spaghetti straps
- torn or cut clothing
- hats or other head coverings
- shoes without socks

HAIR POLICY

Good grooming is expected. It promotes self discipline and helps to eliminate distractions to the learning environment. Hair should be kept clean and cut in a manner that is appropriate for school. Traditional haircuts are required. Trendy or unusual hairstyles are not permitted. Long hair on boys is not permitted; this includes, but is not limited to, hair below the bottom of the collar, on the ears, and/or long bangs. No etching is permitted. Neither girls' nor boys' hair may cover the face or eyes. Bangs must be at or above the eyebrow. Hair should not appear to be unnatural or artificially colored. Bleaching or tipping that appears to be colored is not permitted. Any distracting hair style, color, or cuts are not permitted for boys and girls. The judgement of the administration is final in these matters.

Hairstyles

The administrator reserves the right to have students' hair groomed properly. The hair guidelines for boys and girls include but are not limited to the following:

- hair should be clean and combed neatly
- bangs must be cut above the eyebrows
- hair may not be an "unnatural" color (purple, blue, pink, etc.)
- hairstyles may not be excessive or a distraction during class
- hairstyles involving shaved sides or back of the head are not permitted
- spikes, Mohawks, carvings are not permitted

Boy specific guidance, in addition to the above:

- hair no longer than the bottom collar and not covering the ear
- may not wear sideburns
- must be clean shaven; mustaches, beards goatees are not permitted
